KHARKIV FOUNDATION ACT OF EUROPEAN FEDERATION OF NATIONAL ASSOCIATIONS OF CRIMINALISTS

12 October, 2021

- Being aware of the high vocation of criminalists and forensic scientists' associations,
- taking into account the historical, cultural, moral and legal traditions of the relations between the Lithuanian, Polish and Ukrainian Schools of Criminalistics and Forensic Sciences.
- taking into consideration the European integration aspirations of criminalists and forensic scientists, which is reflected in the creation of international and national non-governmental organizations,
- recognizing the importance of ensuring real mechanisms for the continuous exchange of knowledge between criminalists and forensic scientists in Europe and the World,
- attaching importance to the implementation of the provisions of the Palanga Memorandum aimed at creating a common criminalistic and forensic space in Europe,
- being open to have a new National Associations and National Groups as a member of European Federation,

the International Criminalists Congress (Ukraine), Lithuanian Association of Criminalists and Polish Association of Criminalists signed this Foundation Act and obliges Lithuanian Association of Criminalists by September 1, 2022:

- 1. Together with partners prepare and adopt the founding documents of European Federation of National Associations of Criminalists.
- 2. Together with partners agree on the project statute of European Federation of National Associations of Criminalists.

3. Prepare the treaty establishing the European Federation of National Associations of Criminalists and sign it in 2022 during the XVIIth International Congress "Criminalistics and Forensic Expertology: Science, Studies, Practice" in Vilnius (Lithuania) on September 8-10.
